Minor updates to the Core and Configuration plugins to resolve a number of initialisation issues, and to ensure Website Administrators do not delete critical information.

Summary for Website Administrators: The updates will ensure certain functions in the u3agrouplist widget are correctly initialised. In addition the update will prevent Website Administrators inadvertently deleting critical data that will result in their website becoming inaccessible. This release does not provide any new feature or enhancements.

New Features, Enhancements or Bug Fixes.

Plugin	Summary of Reason
Configuration	$\#1047^{\ddagger}$ Remove the ability of a Website Administrator to delete the WordPress Address (URL), which results in a broken site
Configuration	$\#1049^{\ddagger}$ Change to decrease the probability of a Website Administrator inadvertently deleting the SiteWorks administrative user.
Core	# 1042 To remove the listing of events that are associated with an group that is stored as a <i>draft</i> .
Core	# 1046 To resolve the issue where <i>Display Options</i> section of the properties panel does not initially show the <i>SORT ORDER</i> option, but this does not initially appear. The option only appears when <i>CATEGORY</i> is set to a single category then back to <i>All categories</i> .
Core	# 1048 To resolve the issue where venue is not correctly initialised when using the shortcode [u3agrouplist venue="y"]

[‡] **Important note**: the configuration fixes should only apply to SiteWorks project hosting. Hence will only apply if the following configuration variables are be set (typically in wp-config.php)

- #1049 SITEWORKS_HOSTING should be defined with the value 1
- #1047 U3A_SYSADMIN should be defined as the admin username that should be protected, e.g. define('U3A_SYSADMIN', 'adminUserName')

Known Defects or Limitations

LiteSpeed Cache: This is an ongoing issue, currently the plugin should not be activated. Detailed in OpenProject #972, Change Board Minute 11.
