

SiteWorks: Release Note

Contact Form 1.1.1

5 Septembert 2024

This update provides a enhancement that provides the ability to use two or more contact forms across a site. While this was originally developed for regional or similar sites that have sub-sites, it is recognised that this could be beneficial across all SiteWorks sites, to provide a degree of customisation, for example between contacting a group leader or committee member, hence its release across all SiteWorks sites.

Summary for Website Administrators: The 1.1.1 version of the u3a SiteWirks contact form, will permit a web manager to provide a number of customised contact forms within a single site. This will be beneficial to a Regional, Network or similar site that provides "sub-sites" for smaller u3as or groups. This feature may also be useful in a regular SiteWorks site if the web manager wants to have different content on the contact page depending on who is being contacted. *The change will be documented in both the training and user guides.*

Plugin	Summary of Reason
Contact Form	# 1071. Enhancement to the Contact Page plugin. The contact form plugin currently only supports a single pre-defined contact form page. For a Region or similar site that provides "sub-sites" for smaller u3as or groups, a proposed enhancement would allow a separate contact form page be used for the each individual sub-site. It is recognised that this feature may also be useful in a regular SiteWorks site if the web manger wants to have different content on the contact page depending on who is being contacted. The approach adopted is to extend the [u3a_contact] shortcode to allow an additional optional parameter of "slug", which would be the page slug of the page that is used to trigger the contact form page for a specific contact. For example: [u3a_contact name="Secretary" email = "sec@example.com" slug="slug-of-page"] The deforlt shortcode will not change.

Known Defects or Limitations

LiteSpeed Cache: This is an ongoing issue, currently the plugin should not be activated. Detailed in OpenProject #972, Change Board Minute 11.
