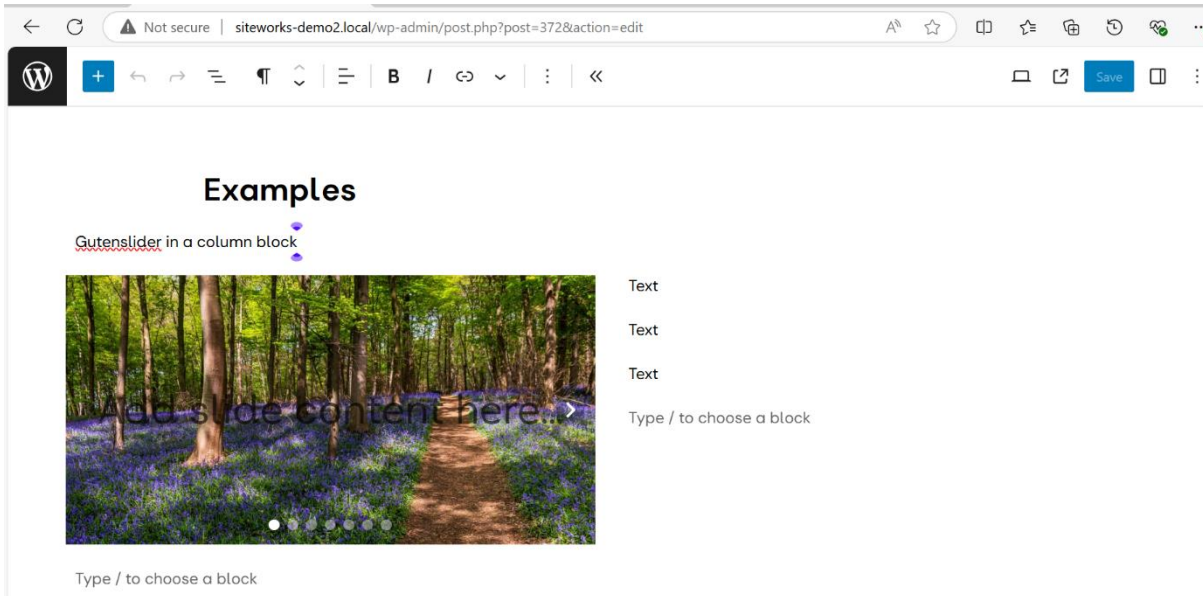


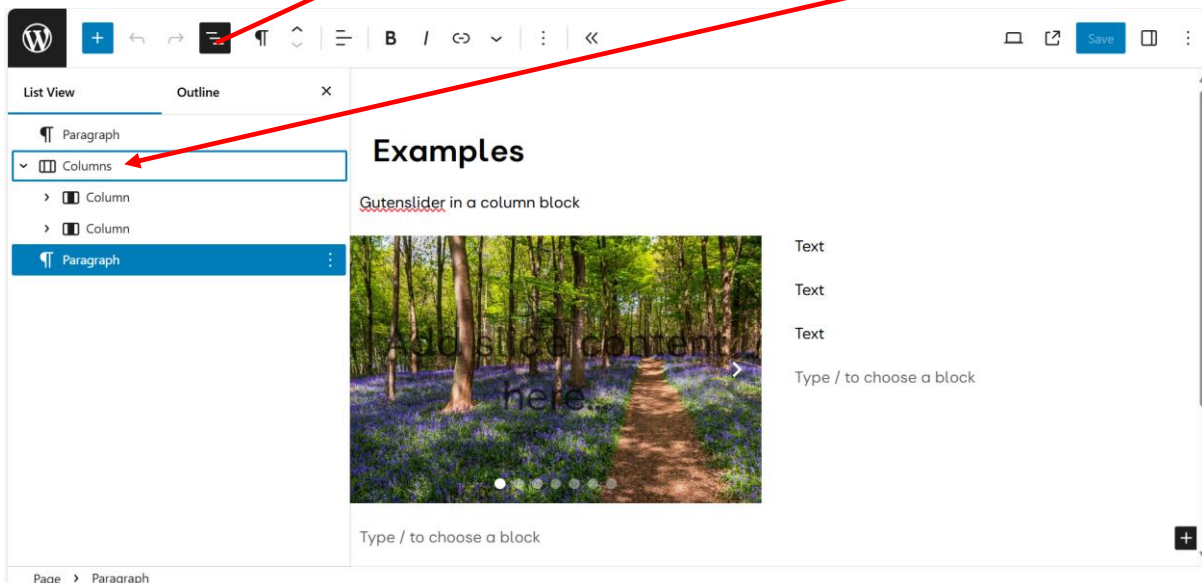
14. SW How to change Gutenslider image display settings

When you add images to a Gutenslider the default display setting for the image is Cover. This setting can be changed by following the steps in the follow screenshots.

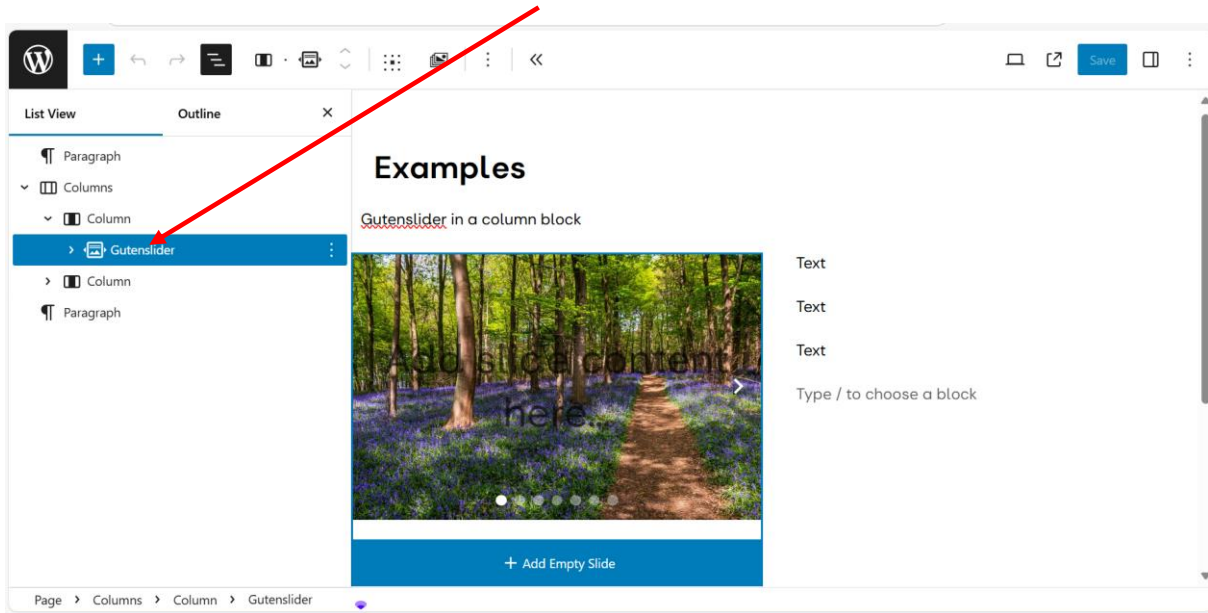
Screenshot 1. shows a Gutenslider in Column 1 of a two Column Block. Column 2 contains text.



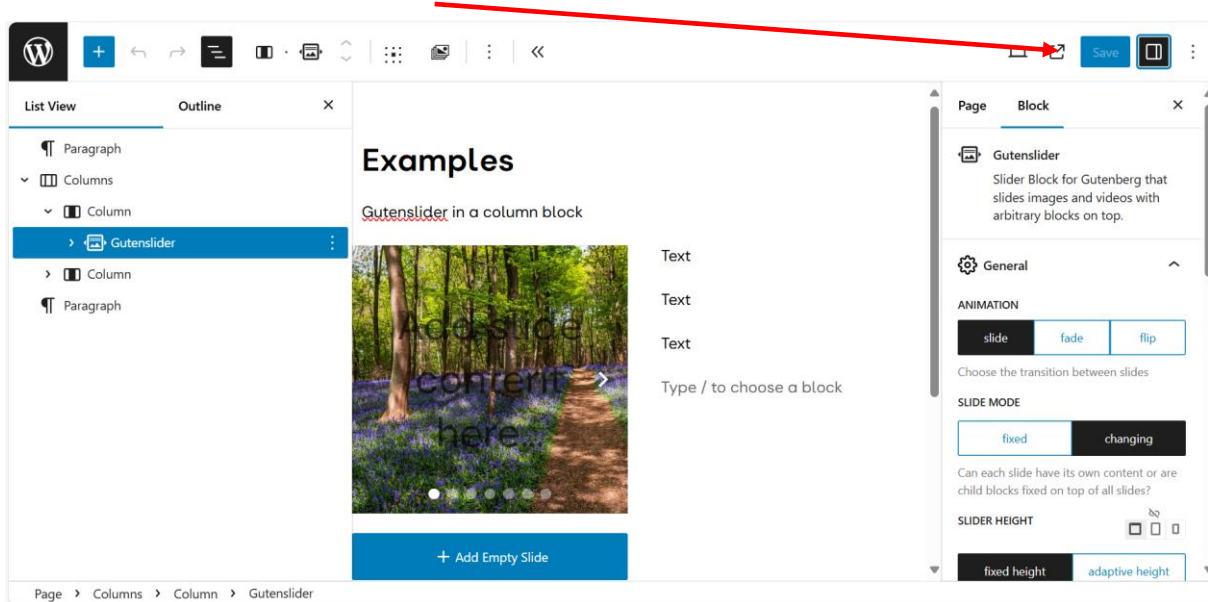
Screenshot 2. Open the Hamburger menu, here I am moving to the Column Block that contains the Gutenslider.



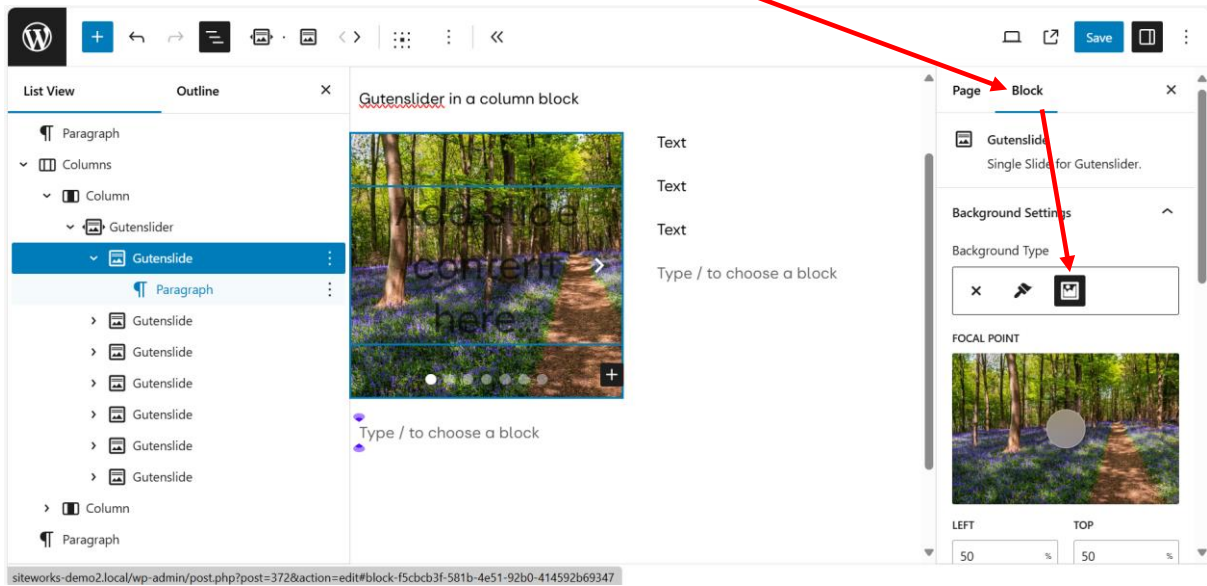
Screenshot 3. Next select the Gutenslider which is in the first Column.



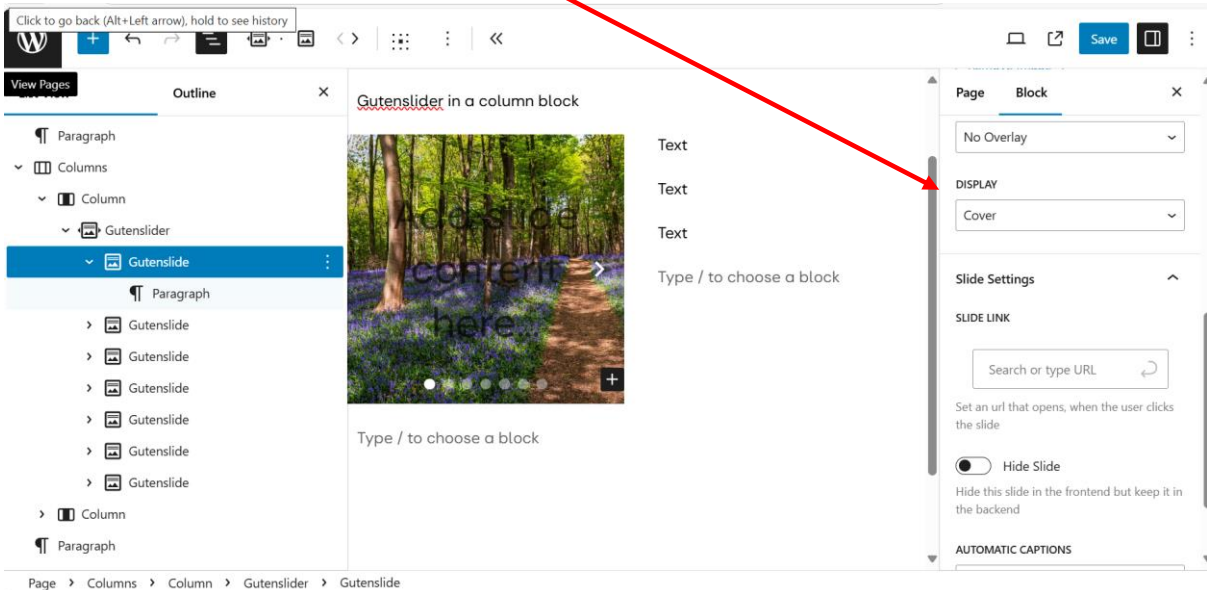
Screenshot 4. Open the setting menu top right.



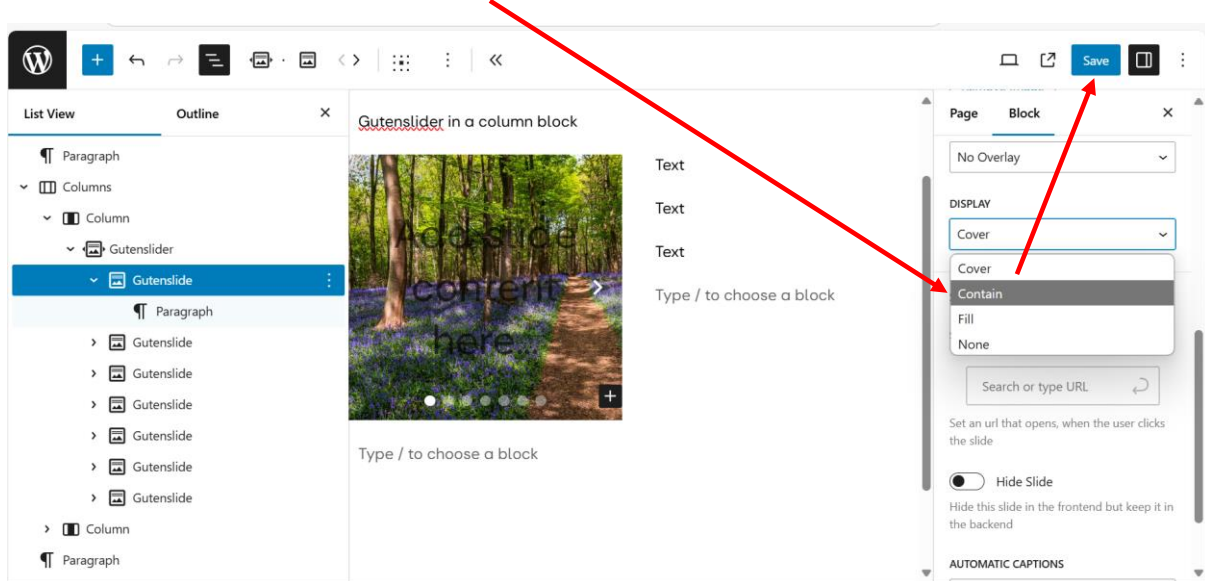
Screenshot 5. From the settings menu select block then image as shown.



Screenshot 6. Scroll down to DISPLAY you will see it is set to Cover.

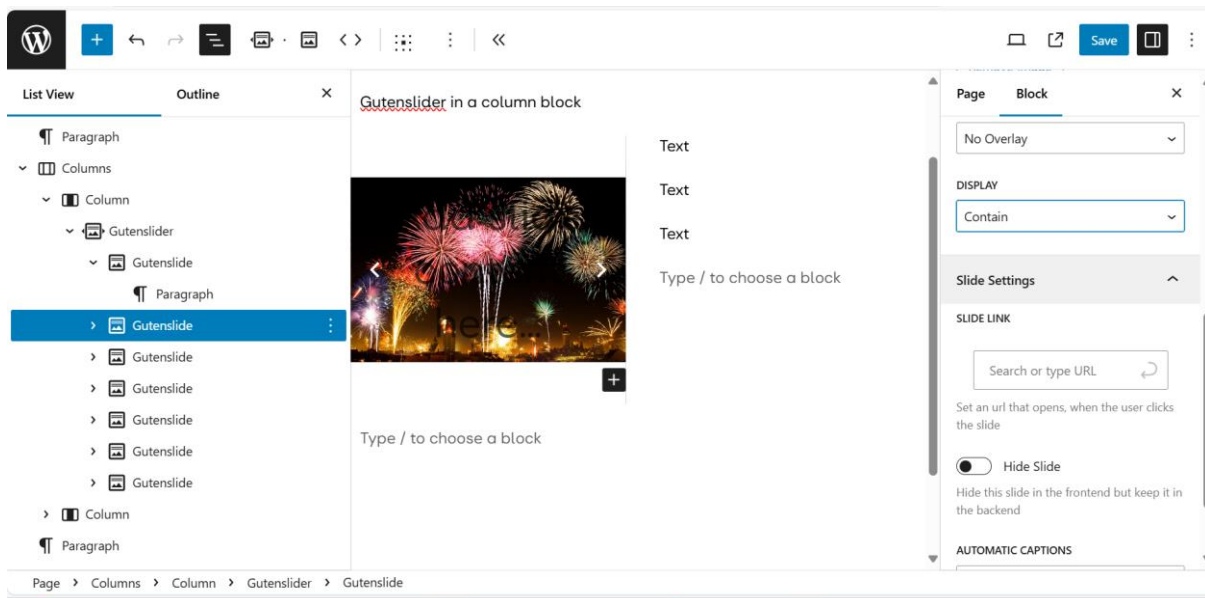


Screenshot 7. Click on the Cover dropdown and select contain and then Save.



Screenshots 8 & 9. Repeat this for the other images in the Gutenberg slider.

You can further adjust the image height by adjusting the height of the Gutenberg slider. You can also justify the position of the of the Gutenberg slider and individual images via their pop up menus.
