

SiteWorks: Release Note

Removal of LiteSpeed Cashe

27 November 2024

This update confirms the removal of LiteSpeed Cache for the SiteWorks distribution.

Summary for Website Administrators: LiteSpeed Cache was added to the SiteWorks distribution to reduce the sever load, provide faster delivery of pages to users and provide increased resilience to DOS (denial of service) attacks. After extensive real world testing, the plugin has caused significant issues in the sites where it was activated. For this reason it has been agreed to remove the plugin from the distribution and from all sites.
