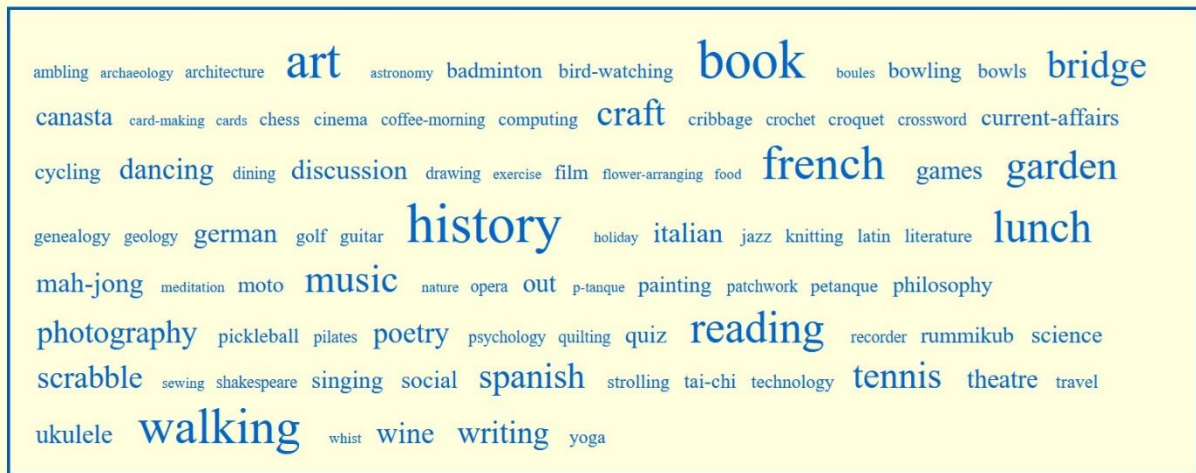
## Oversights
